

100,000 Strong in the Americas Scholarship

Dear student:

Thank you very much for your interest in the 100,000 Strong in the Americas Scholarship. Please, take in consideration the following information:

- The scholarship is available for all UC students, which are taking courses from 2nd to the
 last year of their degree program, that will be taking courses during 2019. Students only
 taking their final project course or are only preparing their final project/ thesis aren't
 elegible for this scholarship.
- This scholarship includes team work with our partners in the US. That means that our students need to be available at leats three hours a week starting February/March until the start day of the program in Mendoza when they will need full time availability for the program. Please take this into consideration if you have a full time job.
- Program dates:
 - o Mendoza: from June 1st until June 11th
 - O US: from June 11th until June 21st

Requirements:

1. Academics

- Presentation letter with basic information about the applicant (see cover letter file): full name, ID number, date of birth, address, telephone number, e mail address, degree program and year, file number, etc.
- Grade point average
- Academic status:
 - Amount of courses of your degree program
 - o Amount of courses taken
 - o Amount of courses passed
 - o Amount of courses left to be taken

2. English proficiency:

- Certificate/s of English course/s taken in the past
- Proficency exam
- Personal interview

3. Personal

- Resume including all type of activities (social, volunteer work, educational, etc) –all activities matter-.
- Recommendation letter from a professor/ program director/ dean/ rector of the UC, describing why you're a good candidate for the scholarship.
- Personal essay: mínimum of one A4 page telling us why you're interested in the subject matter of the program and why you're a good candidate.

Application Process:

Applicants must hand in a folder with all the required forms, documents and information in A4 printed format at the office of the Secretaría de Cooperación Internacional on the first floor.



Application Deadline:

Friday, February 1st at 5 pm.

Applications (folders) will not be received after that day and time, under any circumstances.

Personal interviews:

Once a pre-selection of eligible students is done, personal interviews will take place the week of February 4th. Pre-selected students will be informed via e-mail of the day, time and place they will have their personal interview. The rest of the students will be informed of the decline of their application, also via e-mail.

Final results and announcements:

The final announcement of the scholarship winners will take place February 15th. All pre-selected students will receive an e-mail with their results. The scholarwship winners will be mentioned on our UC's web site and social media.
