

Deadline 2nd semester (August - December)	May 29th, 2026			
Requirements	1- Be a regular enrolled student at the home university.			
	2- Pay the monthly tuition fees (if applicable) at the home university during the exchange period.			
	3- Be accepted by Universidad de Congreso.			
	4- Arrange and cover the costs of round-trip travel to the city of Mendoza.			
	5- Assume the costs of accommodation and living expenses during the exchange period.			
	6- Have valid international health insurance for the entire stay in Argentina.			
	7- Hold a valid passport throughout the exchange period.			
Documents required for application	1- Admission form from Universidad de Congreso, completed and signed by the home university.			
	2- Academic transcript or record of courses completed to date.			
	3- Letter of recommendation from the head of the relevant department or academic program.			
	4- Scanned copy of a valid passport.			
	5- Scanned copy of international health insurance.			
	6- Criminal Records Certificate			
	(required depending on time-stay and Country).

Housing	Universidad de Congreso does not offer on-campus housing. Exchange students may request a list of housing options from the Office of International Cooperation. This list includes homestays, student residences, and apartment rental services. Students are responsible for arranging their own accommodation.
Estimated Monthly Living Costs (including housing)	The cost of living varies depending on the type and location of housing, as well as personal spending habits. On average, monthly living expenses range from USD 400 to 800.
Immigration Procedure	Our office assists with the processing of the Electronic Entry Registration (TIE 24H) or consular visa, although this is a personal and mandatory procedure for all students entering Universidad de Congreso.
Transfer-in	Our office can coordinate transportation from the airport or bus terminal to the student's accommodation through a trusted private car service (remis). The fee is fixed and communicated at the time of booking. The cost is covered by the student.
Buddy System Program	We offer a volunteer student program designed to support exchange students in integrating into both university life and the city of Mendoza.

LANGUAGE INSTRUCTION

Spanish: Students coming from non-Spanish-speaking countries are required to provide proof of Spanish language proficiency. The minimum required level is B1.

Additionally, all students must take an internal placement test prior to arrival.
